**Non-Uniform Day
Friday 18th March 2022**

We will be hosting our termly non-uniform day later this week on Friday 18th March. This date also marks the 2022 Red Nose Day, however, our Student School Council have instead decided to support a different cause.

Over the past three weeks, the conflict unfolding between Ukraine and Russia has created over 2.5 million refugees who have had to suddenly flee their homes. Our students would like to support refugees who have had to seek shelter far away from their homeland and depend on the kindness of others.

Students can pay a voluntary contribution of £1.00 to come to school in non-uniform, wearing something blue and yellow if possible. Please be mindful that clothing and footwear should be sensible and inoffensive, and should uphold the school's 3R values. We would also like to remind parents and students that our policy regarding jewellery remains unchanged due to health and safety reasons.

Students who have a timetabled practical PE lesson on Friday (week B) must still bring their correct PE kit to school with them, but are welcome to still take part in the non-uniform day.

Additionally, pin badges will be available for students to purchase, which they will be allowed to wear on their uniform blazer lapel after the event if they wish. 100% of money raised from the voluntary contributions will be donated to refugees to support the efforts amidst the current crisis.
